PRAYERS

Section 1: Hunger and Passion for the things of God

Bible Texts

(Psa 42:1) As the hart panteth after the water brooks, so panteth my soul after thee, O God.

(Rom 5:5) And hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us.

Confession

I (*insert name*) have the life of God in me by His Spirit. That life has taken over every desire and longing of my soul and spirit; permeating every organ and cell in my body. I long for more of God at all times. Jesus is the Vine; I am a branch of the Vine here on earth. God's life flows through Jesus Christ to me, drawing me ever closer to the knowledge of His son. The Spirit of God has produced in me the fruits of love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, humility, and self-control. Section 2: Health

Bible Texts

(Matthew 8:16 KJV) When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with his word, and healed all that were sick:

(1Pe 2:24) Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.

Confession

Jesus healed all that were sick, that it might be fulfilled, that which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet saying, "He took our infirmities and bear our sicknesses." I declare into my life and body, and over the bodies of every member of my family, speaking forth the words of the same Jesus. And by these words I speak forth, if demonic spirits are in operation concerning ailments or sicknesses, I declare they are cast out this moment as I speak forth the words of Christ. For it's the same Jesus who healed them all, who now lays His hands upon my head as I declare His words out of my lips.

Bible Text

Luke 7:6 So Jesus went with them. But just before they arrived at the house, the officer sent some friends to say, "Lord, don't trouble yourself by coming to my home, for I am not worthy of such an honor. 7 I am not even worthy to come and meet you. Just say the word from where you are, and my servant will be healed. 8 I know this because I am under the authority of my superior officers, and I have authority over my soldiers. I only need to say, 'Go,' and they go, or 'Come,' and they come. And if I say to my slaves, 'Do this,' they do it."

Confession

As we jointly decree tonight, we send prophetic utterances and instructions into our homes, hospital wards, sickbeds and deathbeds. We decree and declare by the authority in the name of Jesus that everyone bedridden by an illness receives the word of the Lord tonight and they are completely made whole. We return home rejoicing as we behold the wonders of the Lord in their lives in Jesus' name. Amen.

Section 3: Wealth

Bible Texts

(Gal 3:13-14) Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, cursed is everyone that hangeth on a tree: (14) That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

(2 Cor 8:9) For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich.

Confession

Through the Blood of Jesus Christ, every curse over the ground in which I *(insert name)* labour has been broken. (Act 20:34 - 35) Yea, ye yourselves know, that these hands have ministered unto my necessities, and to them that were with me. (35) I have shewed you all things, how that so labouring ye ought to support the weak, and to remember the words of the Lord Jesus, how he said, It is more blessed to give than to receive.

Confession :

Section 6: Favour

Bible Texts

(Psa 44:3) For they got not the land in possession by their own sword, neither did their own arm save them: but thy right hand, and thine arm, and the light of thy countenance, because thou hadst a favour unto them.

(Psa 44:4) Thou art my King, O God: command deliverances for Jacob.

*(Psa 5:12) For thou, LORD, wilt bless the righteous; with favour wilt thou compass him as *with* a shield.*

Confession :

I (*insert name*) am the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus. The Lord has sent help and light out of heaven to me.
